**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF  
ERIC BLOW REGARDING  
DISSEMINATION OF SETTLEMENT  
NOTICE AND CLAIMS RECEIVED**

1 I, Eric Blow, declare and state as follows:

2 1. I am a Project Manager employed by Epiq Class Action & Claims Solutions, Inc.  
3 (“Epiq”). The following statements are based on my personal knowledge and information  
4 provided by other Epiq employees working under my supervision and, if called on to do so, I  
5 could and would testify competently thereto.

6 2. Epiq was retained by Class Counsel for the Class in the above-captioned litigation  
7 (“Action”), and appointed pursuant to the Court’s September 19, 2025 Order Granting Lead  
8 Plaintiffs’ Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, For Issuance of Notice  
9 to the Class, and for Scheduling of Fairness Hearing (ECF 107) (“Preliminary Approval Order”).  
10 Epiq was authorized to act as the Claims Administrator in connection with the Settlement  
11 reached in the above-captioned Action.<sup>1</sup> I submit this Supplemental Declaration in order to  
12 provide the Court with additional information regarding the mailing of the Notice of Pendency  
13 and Proposed Settlement of Class Action (the “Settlement Notice”), exclusions or objections  
14 received to date, and the Claims received to date.

15 **DISSEMINATION OF THE SETTLEMENT NOTICE**

16 3. As described in the Declaration of Eric Blow Regarding (1) Dissemination of  
17 Settlement Notices; (2) Publication of the Summary Notice; (3) and Establishment of Telephone  
18 Hotline and Settlement Website (ECF 112-3) (“Initial Mailing Declaration”), in accordance with  
19 the Preliminary Approval Order, Epiq commenced the mailing of the Settlement Notice to  
20 potential Class Members on October 17, 2025.

21 4. As of February 9, 2026, a total of 9,478 Settlement Notices have been  
22 disseminated to potential Class Members and Nominees by first-class mail.

23 5. As of February 9, 2026, 28 Settlement Notices have been returned by the United  
24 States Postal Service to Epiq as undeliverable. USPS automatically forwarded Settlement Notice  
25 with available forwarding address orders that had expired. Settlement Notices returned as

1 undeliverable were remailed to any new address information available through USPS  
2 information, and to better addresses that were found using a third-party lookup service. This  
3 number of undeliverable Settlement Notices is consistent (or lower than) comparable notice  
4 programs.

5 **OBJECTIONS AND REQUESTS FOR EXCLUSION**

6 6. As of February 9, 2026, zero (0) Class Members have objected to or commented  
7 on the Settlement, Lead Counsel's request for attorneys' fees, payment of litigation expenses,  
8 and service award. Similarly, zero (0) Class Members have requested to be excluded from the  
9 Settlement.

10 **CLAIMS RECEIVED TO DATE**

11 7. The Settlement Notice also informed potential members of the Class that if they  
12 wished to receive a payment from the Settlement, they must submit a Claim Form to Epiq, with  
13 supporting documentation, postmarked or received by January 16, 2026. As of February 9,  
14 2026, Epiq has received 6,108 claims, which represents a claims rate of approximately 64.4% of  
15 the 9,478 Settlement Notices disseminated. This claims rate is higher than the typical claims rate  
16 observed in similar notice programs.

17 8. Epiq's preliminary analysis of the Claims submitted to date shows that 50 paper  
18 Claims have been received, 222 claims have been submitted electronically via the case website,  
19 and 5,836 electronic Claims have been submitted by institutional filers based on Epiq's  
20 preliminary review of the Claims received.

21 9. All Claims are still subject to a comprehensive review under Epiq's standard  
22 claims-processing procedures, which will identify any deficiencies and conditions of ineligibility  
23 in Claims. Claimants will then be given an opportunity to correct their Claims. Accordingly, it  
24 is not possible to report valid and invalid Claims at this time.

25 **UPDATE ON CALL CENTER AND WEBSITE**

26 10. Epiq continues to maintain the toll-free phone number for this Action, 1-888-851-  
27 6078 and interactive voice response system to accommodate any inquiries from potential Class  
28 Members. As of February 9, 2026, Epiq has received a total of 73 incoming calls to the toll-free

1 number dedicated to this Settlement. Epiq has promptly responded to each telephone inquiry and  
2 will continue to address potential Class Members' inquiries. Epiq also continues to maintain the  
3 dedicated website for the Action, [www.LunaInnovationsSecuritiesLitigation.com](http://www.LunaInnovationsSecuritiesLitigation.com) (the  
4 "Settlement Website"), to assist potential Class Members. As of February 9, 2026, the website  
5 has received 6,878 page hits and 2,886 unique website sessions. Epiq will continue to maintain  
6 and, as appropriate, update the Settlement Website and toll-free phone number until the  
7 conclusion of the administration.

8 11. Epiq uploaded Lead Plaintiff's final approval motion (ECF 110) and Lead  
9 Counsel's fee and expense application (ECF 111) on the Settlement Website after they were filed  
10 on January 13, 2026.

11 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the  
12 foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
